Hetton New Dawn has been involved in working in the communities of Hetton, Easington Lane, Eppleton & Moorsley for over ten years, initially to support the elderly in these communities; then, more recently, to include people of all ages who are living in poverty, whether financial or aspirational. Our activities include a Lunch Club for the elderly, Keep Fit & Craft groups, a Bingo Club, weekly cafes in Hetton & Easington Lane (currently providing takeaway meals for those in food insecurity during lockdown) and monthly Transforming Lives group. We run a Community Allotment and are currently seeking funding to develop a Sensory Garden as part of this project and a Befriending Service. We also support Loaves & Fishes foodbank, which gives out food to those in the area in need.

The "Food for All Community Allotment" provides a space where anyone, of whatever age, can spend time, growing food for themselves and others, as food from the allotment is shared with Loaves & Fishes Foodbank. It is open three days per week, providing the opportunity for learning about growing food, healthy exercise in the open and being part of something that benefits others in the community.

Hetton New Dawn's application is to provide new facilities for the users of the allotment and to refresh other areas after the winter. It includes providing seating at specific points in the garden and upkeep and painting of fences to ensure that they can withstand for another year and a replacement cover for our 6 X 3 metre polytunnel. We currently have no designated monies for our allotment and have been unable to raise funds through our normal activities, which are suspended due to Covid-19. Works will start in mid-March 2021 and be completed by 31st May 2021. The success criteria will be shown through the updating and provision of the facilities previously described.
