### Brief description of organisational aims and activities:

HJFC are a community standard football club (this is a level above the regular charter standard award). We have progressed rapidly over the past few years and now have 350 players registered (age 6-adult) with the club and over 60 volunteers. This includes 3 new girls teams and the return of a Saturday afternoon adult mens team, We hope these additions will help to increase the opportunities for more people to become involved in the future.

Players receive 1 training session per week and 1 game per week. All training equipment is provided on 2-3 year cycle.

Volunteers receive relevant qualifications and training which can include coaching qualifications, child protection courses, first aid training, safeguarding courses and DBS checks.

As part of the clubs growth we have a development programme for 2-6 year olds. This is a key aspect of the continued success. We aim to create 3-4 teams per season to join the club at U7 level.

Our general aims are outlined below as part of our governance document.

1. The objectives of Hetton Juniors Football Club shall be to arrange association football matches and social activities for its members.
2. To encourage the development of sport and recreational activity within the Hetton and surrounding areas as a means of improving both physical and mental health and increasing self-confidence.

3. To provide a supportive environment with a range of activities to foster goodwill and community spirit and to work with others to advance the education of members.
4. To co-operate with other voluntary and statutory agencies in the furtherance of the objectives.
5. To provide an enjoyable, rewarding and positive environment for all members.

The starter pack will allow teams a chance to have a positive start to their time with the club. Having the starter pack will mean that teams can get started with their training straight away, volunteers have the right equipment and checks, players can enjoy being physically active by training and playing games, having 3 to 4 new teams will bring together a range of families from Hetton and the surrounding areas which will include Easington Lane, Moorsley and East Rainton.

The project is to supply 4 teams with a full start up kit. All of the equipment outlined below is essential for the training, games and safety of the players. The DBS checks are around £10 per adult which would be on top of the order below. The club would pay for this as well and the coaches level 1 qualifications (£100 per person).

This would ensure all teams have all they need to come out of lockdown and be ready to train and play. This would benefit up to 32 boys and girls plus 8 volunteers. If successful, we can have the equipment ordered and ready to use by the start of April. This would be in good time as grassroots sport is allowed to resume from the start of April!

Our success criteria would be the kit being ordered, used and having 4 teams up and running by the start of May.
